USING THE TUCKSHOP

The teachers from each class will send up to the Tuckshop two(2) "Tuckshop Monitors" to pick up the lunch for their whole class. The lunches will be taken back to class and handed out to the children who have ordered. Once the release from class bell has gone, each child from year 1 to year 6 has the opportunity to come to the Tuckshop and purchase over the counter items, such as cupcakes, biscuits, chips, popcorn, drinks etc. There will be no hot food or pre made food (sandwiches etc) for sale during the breaks. Juniors can have up to \$2 to spend and Seniors can have up to \$5. There is no sharing of money or buying for friends.

Forgotten Lunch – You will be provided with a vegemite or cheese sandwich and a piece of fruit. An invoice of \$4 will be sent home for immediate payment.

All Volunteers are Welcome. Mum, Dad, Grandparents* Aunts* & Uncles* (*will require a blue card) So bring a friend and come along. The tuckshop can only remain open with the help of volunteers. OSHC

(Outside School Hours Care & Vacation Care)

The Jamboree Heights Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) Service operates from within the school grounds and can provide care to all students of JHSS and surrounding community, for both before and after school hours and vacation care. The service is also able to offer casual care during their operation hours.

The service features a modern, purpose-built facility containing wonderful resources to stimulate and occupy your child's mind whilst care is being provided by fully qualified and experienced staff.

The service program contains structured craft activities and fun-based physical games and recreational challenges, aimed at ensuring all groups and abilities are recognised and provided for at every session.

A nutritional afternoon tea is provided each afternoon and breakfast is provided each morning.

The service is fully licensed by the Office of Early Childhood Education and Care. Attendance at the service is subject to completion of an enrolment form which is available from the OSHC room daily from 6.30 - 9.00am and from 2.00 - 6.30pm.

The Vacation Care program is offered during each school holiday period with imaginative themed days and fun-packed excursions catering for all age groups. Attendance at vacation care requires a separate enrolment form available from the service 4-6 weeks prior to each holiday break.

Hours of Operation:

Before School Care: 6.30 - 9am (years 1-6 are signed out at 8.40am; preps are escorted to class at 8.50am)

(During Term 1 & Term 2 the Year 1's are escorted to and from class.)

After School Care: 3 - 6.30pm (years 1-6 make their own way to the OSHC building; preps are collected from class)

Vacation Care: 6.30am - 6.30pm

Note - the service does not operate on public holidays and is closed for two weeks over the Christmas / New Year period.

Information regarding fee structure, payment and eligibility for CCMS (Childcare Management System) can be obtained by contacting the service.

- Remain objective and avoid personal bias at all times
- Represent all members of the school community
- Engage the school and wider community in developing and effecting school priorities, policies and decisions in a manner that is consultative, respectful and fair
- ❖ Declare and conflicts of interest and not misuse their office to advance individual views or for personal gain
- ❖ Make fair, transparent and consistent decisions
- Provide objective and independent advice
- ❖ Listen and be tolerant of the views and opinions of others, even if those views and opinions differ from their own
- Treat official information with care and use it only for the purpose for which it was collected or authorized
- Respect confidentiality and information privacy (about the school, community members, staff or students) at all times and not disclose confidential information
- ❖ Not use confidential or privileged information to further personal interests
- ❖ Be responsive to the requirements of the school community
- ❖ Seek to achieve excellence in educational outcomes for all students at the school
