We are a local state school who are seeking potential sponsorship partners within our local business district. We are hosting our first Trivia Night. Our school has over 850 students encompassing over 550 individual families. Within our school community we have a large portion of students who on occasion require financial assistance. The P&C established the Student Welfare Fund in 2017 which helps assist these students and their families in times of hardship.

The Student Welfare Fund is a fund available for students who encounter unforeseen circumstances during their time in JHSS that causes them unexpected financial strain. Some examples of issues which may make students eligible for the welfare fund are bereavement, illness or injury, sudden unemployment, or family breakdown. This Trivia Night will operate as the main fundraiser for this fund in 2018.

Since its establishment the Student Welfare funds have helped provide students in need uniforms, access to our music and sporting programs and aided families in general need. The primary goal is to allow all students equitable access to all resources, facilities and programs available at the school.
