2018 Family Contribution

The Jamboree Heights State School Parents & Citizens Association has a long tradition of funding projects around the school that benefit all our students.

The objectives of the association are to promote the interests of, and facilitate the development and further improvement of the school, by promoting parent participation, encouraging close cooperation between parents, students and staff and promoting positive community support. We aim to give every child at our school a fair go. To do this we need your help. This annual levy helps us pay for much needed resources in and around the school. Please note this is different to the one the school issues in term 1.

Our current goal is to raise \$25, 000 to upgrade the upper oval area and begin fixing the irrigation and flooding on the oval. To help us we are asking parents to contribute to this annual P&C Levy.

Since 2013, we have raised, procured and utilized over \$1 Million in the school community. This has come from grants, fundraisers and this levy. The P&C has used the money raised by this levy to fund many large projects and improvements for the school that would not be supplied otherwise.
